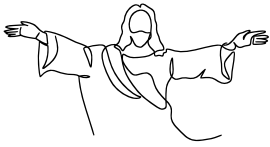

## Sight Word Books

Almost all of our class has sight word books now (if your child does not, please do not worry, that just means we are working on more important foundational skills first, we do not want to rush their brains or confuse them if they are not ready). Please practice these daily. The idea is that they commit them to memory. In order to "pass" a page with me, they will need to do the words fairly quickly so that I know it is rote memory. I do the words in different orders weekly. They can test on multiple pages each week - IF their brain is able to memorize more than one or two pages at a time. This is not a race!! I will begin testing kids on different days. See the schedule below. If your child's name is on here but does NOT have a book yet, this will just be their day in the future once they do get a book!

The days they do their sight word books are the same days that they do show and tell.

## This Week We Learned

Religion: We have been learning about Jesus choosing His disciples to be His helpers, to share His love, and to tell others about Jesus.

Math: We have learned about numbers 11-20. This has been TRICKY for many students. We are learning how to write those numbers, how to count up from formed groups of 10. We are also learning the words for each of those numbers and number recognition. Please continue to work on these skills at home if you see that your child struggles with it!

ELA: We met Hot Rod this week and have been learning about the letter "Hh". We are learning to use "invented spelling" or "phonetic spelling" and are working on our writing skills more and more by beginning a daily writing journal!

Science/Social Studies: We began our unit on weather! The kids seem to really be enjoying this as it ties in to our calendar we've done daily all year! This unit will take 2-3 weeks.
