This is certainly what Theophilus becomes by the grace of God, through hearing the news of his Savior.

In any case, Luke wanted to deepen Theophilus's familiarity with Jesus' life and teachings, as is God's goal as we share His Word with our families. As you read God's Word in faith, pray that you, too, are strengthened in your faith and grow in your friendship with and love of God and begin to grasp the magnitude of God's love for us. As you begin to see how God loves all people and wants all to love Him, you will also see that He calls us to be His witnesses to the end of the earth and to present an account of what we know so that others will be strengthened in *their* faith.
