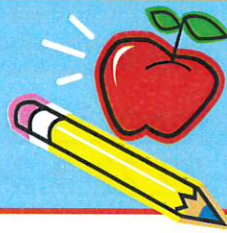

The church at this time was set up so that the temple treasury was located in a court area, which allowed both men and women to be present. Receptacles were placed in the court in order for worshipers to be able to place their contributions in while others looked on. Placing an offering at the temple was a show of status and a social event.

But Jesus does the unexpected. He draws the disciples' attention to the widow. Jesus shocks the disciples by saying that this widow has given the most: "this poor widow has put in more than all those who are contributing to the offering box" (Mark 12:43). What happened to the mighty widow? Knowing the grace and love of our Savior, one would imagine that she is enjoying the riches of heaven! This widow with her little mite was used by Jesus to teach a mighty lesson!
