Religion

During our religion time, we have been learning about Jesus' death and burial.

At the time of Jesus' death, three astonishing events occurred. First, the temple curtain was torn in two, from top to bottom. This curtain separated the Holy Place from the Most Holy Place. It is important to note that the curtain was torn from top to bottom, signifying that God is the one who ripped the thick curtain.

Second, a strong earthquake occurred, splitting rocks. Jesus' death was a stupendous, earth-shaking event that even affected the world He created.

In the book of Matthew is where the third event occurred: "The tombs also were opened. And many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised, and coming out of the tombs after His resurrection" (Matthew 27:52-53). Many Bible scholars believe that the tombs broke open at Christ's death, probably by the earthquake; but the bodies were not raised until Christ's resurrection. The resurrection of these saints, occurring after Jesus Himself was raised, is a preview of the coming Judgment Day, when all believers will be raised to eternal life.
