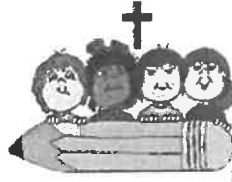

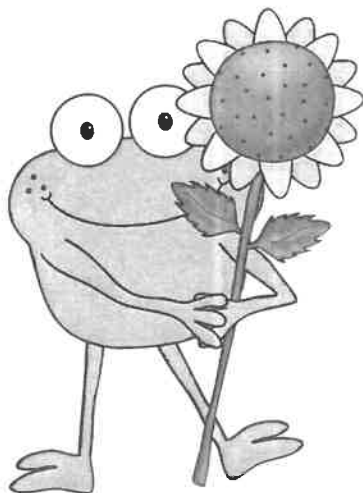
A Note About Our Handwriting Curriculum

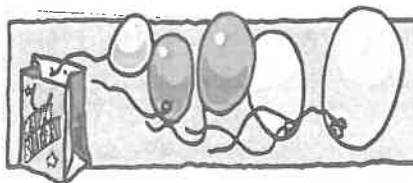
