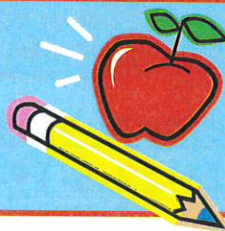

### Religion

During our religion time, we have been learning about Jesus appearing to the disciples and Thomas.

"I'll believe it when I see it" is a phrase we hear in our skeptical world. Thomas could not believe that Jesus had actually risen from the dead. Even though all his friends told him it was so, he refused to believe. However, he did make some exceptions. He told his friends, "Unless I see in His hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into His side, I will never believe" (John 20:25). Thomas thought a risen Jesus was just too good to be true. Of course, we know that Jesus swept away all of Thomas's doubts when He appeared to His disciples a second time.

Children enjoy hearing this story of doubting Thomas, but in reality, he is unbelieving Thomas not doubting. This may be because they feel they know more than Thomas. The children's faith is so strong that they find humor in Thomas's disbelief. They know and are living proof of the blessedness that Jesus speaks about with His disciple, Thomas: "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed" (John 20:29).
