They rejected Jesus and His teachings. The Samaritan helped the injured man physically. Jesus came to seek and save people who were dying in their sins. He gave His life for them so that they might have eternal life.

Our neighbors are not just who we live next to at our homes, it is EVERYONE!! We can love our neighbor by helping him in any physical need. But the best way to be a good neighbor is to help him in his spiritual need by telling him of Jesus and His work of salvation.
