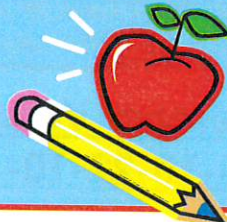

Religion

During our religion time, we have been learning about Moses, the Israelites, and Joshua.

Here is some background information which I shared with the students to get them thinking about our Bible stories for this week.

In our stories of Moses and Joshua this week we learned...in the story of the golden calf it was amazing that any nation who had seen the miracles the people of Israel saw could so quickly and easily turn away from the true God. The people knew that idolatry was wrong.

In the account of the snake on the pole the Israelites traveled so far and were close to the promised land but they grew weary, impatient, and they complained. They had wandered in the desert for 40 years due to their doubting and unbelief. Now we picture ourselves and we are not much different than the Israelites complaining. To stop the rebellion God sent snakes which bit the people and some repented and some did not.

Moses had died and so Joshua became the leader of the tribes. After they crossed the Jordan River, they built an altar with 12 stones.
