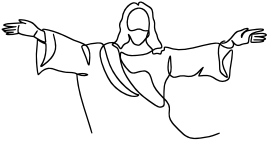


# Kindergarten News - Ms. Breann

## This Week We Learned

**Religion:** Pentecost - Tongues of fire rested on Jesus' disciples; they were filled with the Holy Spirit and could speak different languages. God wants all people to hear of Jesus and to come to faith in Him as their savior. The Holy Spirit makes us brave and glad to share the news of what Jesus has done.

**Math:** We are working on learning numbers 1-100 in order. We are doing some dance videos (Jack Hartman) that include movements with numbers. We are also writing numbers 1-100 with some numbers filled in. As we continue, we will do sheets with less and less numbers filled in. We will begin our "100s Club" next week where we practice writing numbers 1-100 on a chart, and anyone who can do it by the end of the year can hang theirs in the hall and sign a large paper to "join the club" - not as a competition, but as a personal goal!

**ELA:** We finished our unit on "Xx" and "Yy" this week and we began letter "Zz" on Thursday! The "Zz" song is so cute and the kids are already so in love with it! The kids are also doing so great with handwriting with "Zz"! We now OFFICIALLY KNOW OUR ENTIRE ALPHABET!!!

### Science/Social Studies:

- We finished a Magic Tree House book titled "Twister on Tuesday" which is set in the olden days of 1 room school houses. So we learned about how learning used to look different than it does now, but we also dove into storm info, tornado alley, and how to prepare for storms and be safe in them.
- We had a Scholastic Magazine about fiction vs non-fiction books/stories/characters. We were able to create some drawings of our own favorite animals and made up our own fictional character. The kids really loved using their creativity here!
- We created our beautiful life-size butterfly wings! Special thank you to Julie B, Brittany Y, Hope B, Earl B. and my own momma for their help with this project. This project was my mom's vision after seeing it on Facebook and I am so glad to see it come to life after we hatched our own butterflies! The kids have really loved this unit!
- We got to visit 3<sup>rd</sup> grade to see their baby chicks hatching and learn from both Mrs. Grant and her big kids.
