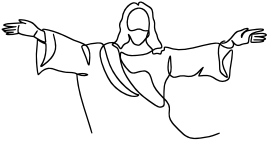

This Week We Learned

Religion: Jesus Prays in the Garden - when Jesus was in anguish, He prayed. Jesus was strengthened to do God's will. When we are tempted not to do God's will, we can pray, confidently trusting God's promise to strengthen us.

Math: We finished our unit on subtraction and began our unit on counting to 100. The kids did AMAZING at subtraction - not a single struggled with subtraction, I am so proud of them! Counting to 100 is a very important skill to master by the end of kindergarten - we want to be able to count to 100, write to 100, and identify all numbers 0-100 in and out of order. This is something you can help with at home. Count with them, count by 1s, by 10s, there are a lot of Jack Hartman videos on YouTube that they enjoy too - we do 1 per day.

ELA: We finished our unit on the letters "Bb" and "Rr", we have just begun the units on "Mm" and "Nn". We are really enjoying our small group time and are learning how to read while working with me and learning rote memorization math facts while on the iPad. These rotations take 10 minutes per group per day. The other two stations are a listening station and math boxes.

Science: We began our unit on the caterpillar/butterfly life cycle this week! We have two cups with 5 caterpillars each that we are observing daily and writing about in our science journals. The kids are loving this and are so excited to see them grow and morph into butterflies in the coming days! We are reading tons of books (fiction and non-fiction)
